TCBC/LUDS May 2024 Trial Instructions and Guidelines

TCBC (The Capitol Bulldog Club) & LUDS (Level Up Dog Sports) has put in place the following procedures for our agility trial at LUDS for the safety of our exhibitors and adherence to State and CDC requirements and guidelines. If you do not feel you can comply with any of these requirements please do not enter our trial, we will look forward to seeing you at a future trial.

There will be no paper course map copies. Maps will be emailed to competitors the day of the trial. We will also have a posting copy on the wall for those exhibitors wishing to take pictures of the course maps.

If you plan on running your vehicle, please park so your exhaust does not go into another vehicle.

One way entry/exit as follows: Enter the building on the parking lot side and exit on the other side where the street goes between the buildings. We will be lining up the next five dog & handler teams to run. Please respect each team's space in the queue.

Exhibitors are responsible for arriving on time for their walk-thrus and runs.

Please bring with you the following:

- Lunch, Snack & Drinks
- A leash that fits in your pocket or around your waist or cross body during your run. Per AKC guidelines: "exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, cross body, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash, this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog were to grab it." A leash-runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.

Crating is allowed indoors. Our space is limited and is first come, first served. Please only take up enough room for your crates. Do not put chairs or other items in crating spaces – please sit in the aisle and put your things on top of or in front of your crate. Please do not save spaces for others.

Shoes – handlers need shoes with low traction to avoid "sticking" to the turf. Trail shoes do not work well. Please choose something with less tread.

Water, snacks, and a light lunch provided for all volunteers.

Dogs entered in the final that do NOT place in a preliminary round may still run, but are not eligible for an overall placement.

FEO RUNS (For exhibition only) ARE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL - ALL HEIGHTS OFFERED

Judging will start no earlier than 8 a.m. each day—Please see Final Confirmation and Trial Information for actual Start times. Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary’s address (max 10 entries per envelope). No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. No entries will be accepted by email, phone or fax. Entries must be submitted on Official AKC-form with correct entry-fees listed. One dog per form. **Please read the section: “Class changes effective January 1, 2021,” posted in the premium, for instructions when entering same dog in multiple heights or mixed regular and preferred classes.** Agreement of back for form **MUST** be signed. Photo-copies must be legible with original signature. Max 10 entries (dogs) per envelope (includes Express-mail-entries). **NO emailed forms, fax or telephone entries accepted.**

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.** Be sure to include correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded

ONLINE ENTRY INFORMATION

You may enter this trial online using LabTestedOnline.com.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows 30% online and 70% paper. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour period, the club reserves the right to increase or decrease either one accordingly.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

PLEASE NOTE:

Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

RINGSIDE - Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2021

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2021, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Rubberized contacts will be used. All classes will take place on synthetic turf. Ring size will be a minimum of 78 x 114 square feet. Clip n Go Rubberized Contacts will be used.

Course WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. No umbrellas allowed on course during walk-throughs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

AKC RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

- ❖ **Flat ribbons will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Scoring is time + faults.**
- ❖ **Overall Winner for each jump height receives a large rosette**

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

MOVE UP REQUESTS

Move ups must be sent in writing (e-mail is acceptable and preferred--NO TEXTS OR INSTANT MESSAGES) to the Trial Secretary for the May, 2024 trial, **no later than Friday May 10th by 9:00 PM.** Move ups from Saturday to Sunday must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last class on Saturday, The trial secretary will be more than grateful if you will do your move-ups as soon as possible.

BIS, AND INJURY REFUND INFORMATION

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday May 17th, 2024.

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a cash refund, less \$6.50 for the 1st run and \$6 for each additional run (per day). A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday, May 17th, 2024. Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian. Requests from chiropractors, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted. Handler illness/injury is excluded from this policy.

SITE INFORMATION

No Exhibitor Setup prior to Friday.

Inside crating is limited and is first come first serve.

All turf accidents must be reported immediately and a \$5 clean up fee has to be paid to Level Up Dog Sports. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) AND FIX AND GO ON

As of January 1, 2021

For Exhibition only (FEO) and Fix and Go On are permanent parts of the AKC Agility program.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

SPECIAL ISC EVENT at Level Up

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC):

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>). Eligibility: This class is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12" & 16" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to World Team Tryouts. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows: → Small (12" jump height) - for dogs measuring 13 ¾" or less at the withers → Medium (16" jump height) - for dogs measuring more than 13 ¾" but less than 16 ⅞" at the withers → Large (24" jump height) - for dogs measuring over 16 ⅞" at the withers.

Prizes:

- Top 3 placements in each class in each jump height will be awarded a flat ribbon and will compete for the overall award in the final round.
- Competitors must enter the final in order to run in the class. Only competitors placing 1st-3rd in a preliminary round are eligible for an overall placement in the final round.
- Runs will be scored time plus faults. All faults are 5 seconds and elimination is 100 seconds.
- Preferred dogs compete with dogs in their regular height. For ex – 4" Preferred will compete with 8" Regular

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
